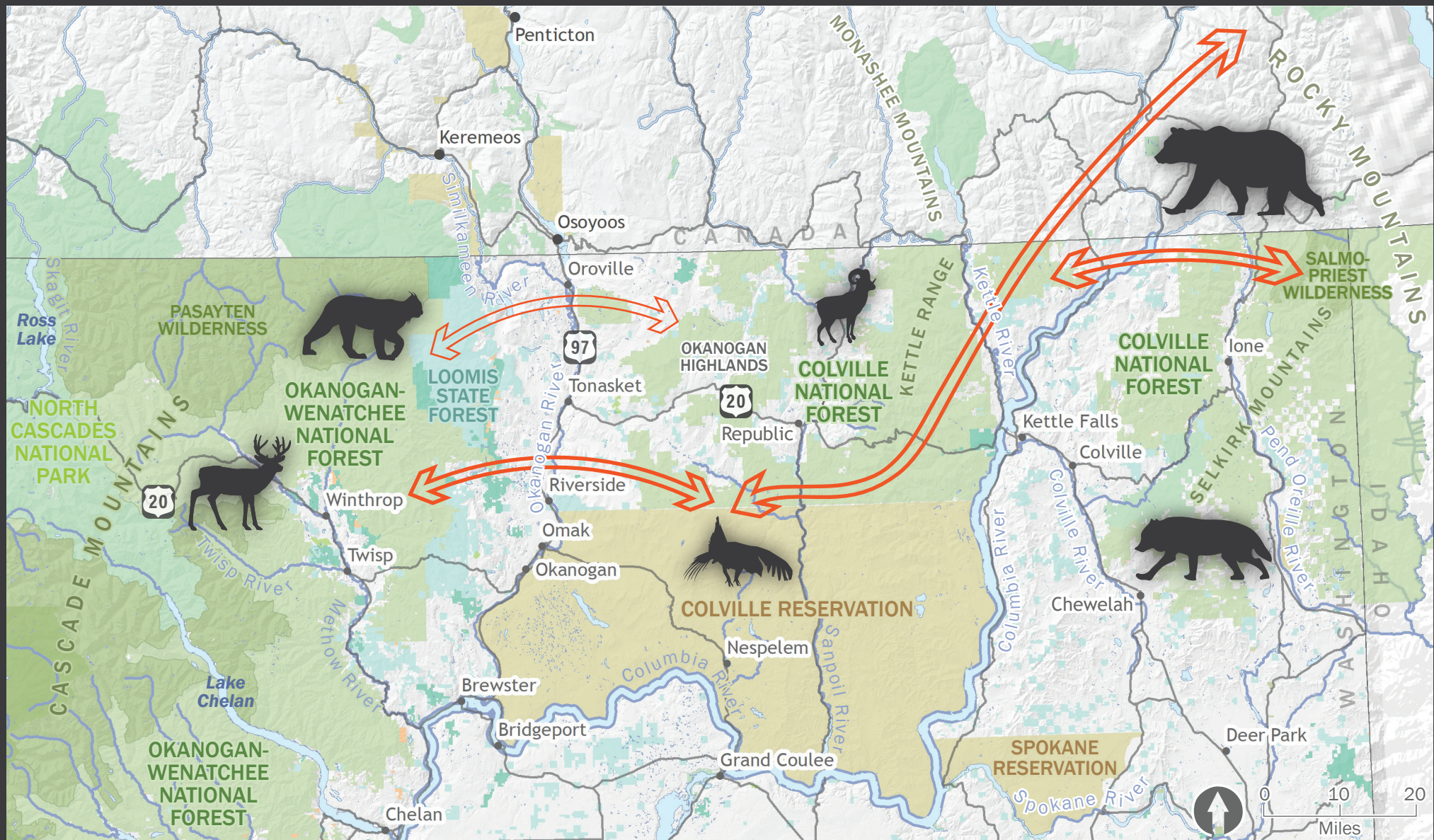


# Cascades to Rockies
