HABITAT RESTORATION

Restoring forest structure, protecting old trees, reintroducing fire and other restoration practices to bolster ecological resilience and natural forest processes.

SPECIES PROTECTION

Protecting and restoring critical habitat for key species like fisher, wolverine, Canada lynx, spotted owl and marbled murrelet.



POLICY ACTION

Educating and lobbying elected leaders to ensure pro-forest policies that protect habitat. improve watershed conditions and restore beneficial fire.



FOREST ADVISORY

Serving as watchdog and partner of the U.S. Forest Service on major restoration efforts in our national forests like the Snoquera Project and Mount Hull.



MONITORING

Monitoring timber projects to ensure they abide by environmental regulations and uphold plans for improved ecological resilience.







PLANTING

Planting thousands of native trees and shrubs to restore habitat in winter forage areas and near wildlife crossings.



MITIGATING DAMAGE

Repairing damage from illegal ATV use while collaborating with responsible recreation groups to prevent future harm to habitat.

ROADS & WATERSHEDS

Removing culverts and ripping out roads to repair watershed function and create safe habitat for bull trout and spawning Chinook salmon.
